Violent and Criminal Incidents

Stockdale Elementary and Stockdale High School had no instances of Violent and Criminal incidents during the 2009 – 2010 school year. Stockdale Junior High had one instance that falls under the definition of Violent and Criminal...possessed prohibited weapon. Stockdale ISD participates in a cooperative with Floresville ISD, La Vernia ISD, Poth ISD, Nixon-Smiley CISD, Falls City ISD, Karnes City ISD, East Central ISD, and Pleasanton ISD to provide an alternative school for students whose behavior requires an alternative placement.

Stockdale ISD strives to be proactive by providing character education programs from kindergarten through high school. These programs include Capturing Kids Hearts, Project Wisdom, and Teen Leadership. In addition to character education and the teen leadership program, the District provides and encourages participation in numerous extracurricular activities. Other programs specific to each campus's needs are also provided.

Stockdale ISD also participates in a StayALERT School Safety Program. One can report school related unsafe, violent or illegal behavior at any time – day or night. The information provided will be forwarded word for word to the main office. One can provide details, including the name of the school by either calling or texting 1-206-406-6485. The person calling or texting does not need to leave their name unless one would like a call back from the district office.

Parental and community involvement in the school is encouraged, and is seen by the district as necessary for the total school and deterring unacceptable behavior.
