## DISTRICTWIDE EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT COMMITTEE Minutes September 6, 2007

Each member present was given a copy of the up-dated 2007-2008 District Improvement Plan and a copy of the 2006-2007 TAKS test results. The plans and the test scores were discussed with input from the members regarding the needed changes to the District Improvement Plan. Ms. Seidel will make changes to the plan as discussed, and the plan will be presented to Board of Trustees at the September 10, 2007 meeting for approval by Superintendent Blincoe.
