

Texas Law

Please Note: In Accordance with Texas State law, **25.083**, we will no longer be allowed to interrupt classes to inform students of changes of plans in the way they get home or call them out of class to be picked up early. We are allowed to make 1 non-emergency interruption per day and we utilize this time for our announcements and pledges. We have devised the following procedures to deal with this matter:

1. Parents **MUST** send a note to school on the morning that the child will leave school early. The note should state the time the student will be picked up. The teacher will then have the student in the office at that time.
2. If it is necessary to change the way your child goes home in the afternoon, you **MUST** call the office as early as possible. **Calls made after 2:30 will not reach your child!** A note will be placed in the teachers boxes as well as an e-mail sent to teachers. They will check their e-mail or box at 2:30. They will **NOT** have time to check them again, so be sure to call **BEFORE 2:30.**
