MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
September 15, 2014

The Board of Trustees of the Stockdale Independent School District held a special called meeting on Monday, September 15, 2014 at 6:30 p.m.

CLOSED SESSION: (Texas Govt. Code Section 551.071)

The Board was called into closed session at 6:32 p.m. for consultation with legal counsel.

The Board reconvened to open session at 7:06 p.m.

Presentation of the Level Three dismissal appeal involving the dismissal of a parent/student grievance for being untimely filed, and the Superintendent's response.
